

# SMCS PTO Meeting Agenda November 8, 2024 The HUB

- 1. Call to Order The President called the meeting at 8:08 am.
  - a. Welcomed 28 in attendance with 2 call-ins

- 2. Minutes
  - a. Review/Approve October meeting minutes from 10/04/2024
    - i. Amendment Bake sale raised \$353 not \$253 as previously stated
    - ii. Motioned: Rochelle: Seconded: Corissa: Yes: 18: No: 0
- 3. Principal's Report Mrs. Parker reiterated to sign up for Flocknote and Class Dojo if you haven't already done so; this is the main communication source to broadcast school messages. Thank you!
- 4. Officers' Reports
  - a. President's Report
    - i. 2024-2025 PTO Projects Brooke briefed a PowerPoint presentation on future school project ideas pulled from the teacher survey, parent survey, and administration. Attached is a copy of the Proposed Strategic Funding Plan for 2023-2024 school year.
    - ii. Action Item: Vote
      - 1. The Strategic Funding Plan was broken down into 2 parts:
        - a. Educational Enrichment Estimated cost \$12,300
          - i. Motioned: Joy: Seconded: April, Yes: 22; No: 0: Abstain: 6
        - b. Campus Beautification Estimated cost \$35,500 with only \$15,500 from savings account and needing to raise \$20,000 to cover all line items.
          - i. Tony volunteered to research/submit Outdoor Classroom grants for SMCS which could alleviate up to \$10,000 in funds needed to be raised. Thank you, Tony!
          - ii. Administration agreed to handle new picnic tables releasing \$5,000 to Security as a line item under Campus Beautification—Motioned: Corissa; Seconded: Dawn; Yes: 18: No: 0: Abstain: 10
          - iii. It was noted that the school already has Stations of the Cross that are used during Lent. It was motioned since the school already has them that the \$4,000 allocated per the slide be moved to fund Playground Equipment which is now funded to \$9,000 instead of only \$5,000. Motioned: Carolyn: Seconded: Joy: Yes: 17; No: 0: Abstain: 11
          - iv. With the above changes voted under Campus
            Beautification, the group voted for the updated Proposed

Strategic Funding Plan-Campus Beautification section-see attachment below. <u>Motioned: Corissa; Seconded: Katie:</u> Yes: 16; No: 2; Abstain: 10


